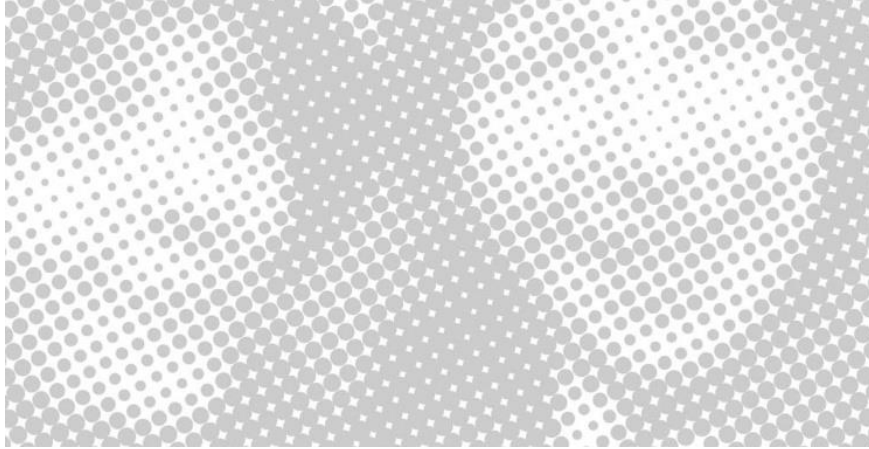


Daughter of Israel Harriet, Tel Aviv
